Project Scope: The Star Mining Company recently (February 2013) reopened the Revenue Mine, one of the largest and most historic mines in Ouray County. The history of this mine begins with the 1876 platting of the Virginus Lode by William Feland. The Virginus is set at the narrow head of a valley located about eight miles west of Ouray at over 12,000 feet in Governor Basin, surrounded on three sides with 13,000 foot snowcapped peaks. Ouray, CO (pop 1,000) is remote SW corner of Colorado. The mine itself is down a six mile long, narrow dirt road, not accessible by tractor trailer. Driving time from Denver is 5 1/2 hours - one way. New mine owners needed furniture for the on-site mine office.

Project Challenges: The challenge (outside of the obvious location) was to get 7 office suites designed, delivered and installed in 8 business days in a remote area with over 24 - 36 inches of new snow expected over that time period. The product selected was Series C and Series A to meet tight budget constraints and varied space requirements. The purchase order was issued on April 10th, 2013. The installation was completed on April 19th with the trucks and a 9 men crew arriving within 30 minutes of the promised delivery time. BBF met all the criteria and performed as promised.
